CHAMP and ISHALL accelerated programs in math and English are designed for gifted students in grades 7-9.

In two years, CHAMP and ISHALL students will complete all four years of high school curriculum, studying the content that is required for Michigan high school graduation and meeting the Common Core National Standards in Math or English.



- Classes held from September 2018-May 2020
- Locations: Avondale School District OR the Tollgate Education Center in Novi.
- Student progress is measured through quizzes, weekly homework assignments, and tests.
- Progress reports and grade reports are sent to each student's family and school.
- Tutoring sessions are available once per week.

Steps to apply for the CHAMP & ISHALL programs in Novi and Avondale:

1. **Very Important: Register for the June ACT test or SAT test by the deadlines listed below.**
2. Online Application: A parent/guardian must create a login and password using your email account at: <https://gateway.gifted.msu.edu/>
3. Set up your account and complete the Student Profile. Click the Submit button.
4. Click Create Application and choose the CHAMP or ISHAL program from the list.
5. Your online application must have all items submitted by May 2nd (grade report and teacher recommendation).
 - a. Your ACT or SAT scores will be available early July, and you must submit them as soon as you receive them.

ACT w/out Writing **\$42.50** (Register at: <http://www.act.org/content/act/en/products-and-services/the-act/registration.html>)

NUMATS ACT w/o Writing \$42 + \$46 = **\$88** (Register at: <https://my.ctd.northwestern.edu>):

Students age 13 or older can register online at the ACT or SAT websites:

- Set up an account at one of the following: www.act.org or <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat>

Students age 12 or younger have two registration options:

- 1) Set up an online account with NUMATS at <https://my.ctd.northwestern.edu> (any age can register via NUMATS)
 - Please note that registering for the SAT or ACT via NUMATS has a higher cost (see above)
- 2) Register with SAT or ACT by paper form (because you are 12 or younger)
 - a. Request a paper registration form from ACT at: http://www.actstudent.org/forms/stud_req/
 - b. ~~OR~~ Request an SAT paper form from the GATE office. Email gifted@msu.edu to request.
 - Allow 7-10 business days for arrival.
 - Fill out and mail in your completed paper form (make sure it is postmarked by the deadline).

INFO FOR ALL STUDENTS:

- An uploaded photo to your online account is not required to register, **but you WILL need to bring some form of acceptable photo identification to be admitted to the test center** (a school ID and/or the identification letter obtained from the testing provider.)
